
We're proud to say our learners' group have just about finished! We plan to hold a graduation dance on Mon June 17th at which point, this happy group will be

We wish everyone travelling up to the National Convention in Darwin in May, Safe travels and most of all have fun!


We look forward to hearing about it and seeing lots of pictures and videos from the National.
